RE: Webster Avenue Programming Request

Dear Aaron:

Thank you for the opportunity to submit this programming request for A/GFTC's consideration. The City is appreciative of the past support A/GFTC has provided on other transportation projects and studies. We would like the A/GFTC to consider a potential project for inclusion on the TIP that would address both a pavement condition issue and a traffic operations issue. The current pavement is beginning to show the early signs of failure. Implementing a pavement preservation project in the near-term will catch the pavement before it further deteriorates and requires more substantial reconstruction. Webster Avenue has an AADT of approximately 1500 and is functionally classified as an Urban Major Collector. Webster Avenue provides a key pedestrian and bicycle connection for residents in the northeast of the City who wish to access Crandall Park. The current sidewalks and curb ramps vary in condition with several locations in need of replacement.

Project Limits:

The proposed project limits are Webster Avenue between Glen Street and Bay Street. Included in these limits are intersection improvements at the Webster Avenue/Glen Street/Fire Road intersection.

Scope of Work:

- Pavement rehabilitation using a 2 inch mill with 2 inch overlay (2,600 feet)
- Spot areas of full depth pavement reconstruction
- Replace sidewalks that do not meet ADA and PROWAG standards (1100 linear feet)
- Replace curb ramps that do not meet ADA and PROWAG standards (12 ramps)
- Drainage improvements at North Road intersection
- Replacement of concrete curbing (2,600 linear feet)
- Closed Drainage System (2,400 linear feet, 14 basins)
- Intersection improvements at Webster Avenue/Glen Street/Fire Road
- **Isolated locations of water main replacement (via City Betterment)**

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Estimated Cost:

Construction: \$1,340,300

Engineering: \$120,000

The City requests that construction money be available in FFY 2022 (October 2021 to September 2022)
