We are submitting the proposed amendment to the 2019-2024 AGFTC TIP for consideration by the Planning Committee at its next scheduled meeting.

The amendment is proposed due to the following:

PROVIDE EXPLANATION FOR CHANGE:

The New York State Department of Transportation has selected various highway segments for pavement resurfacing as part of the statewide asset management initiative to improve pavement conditions. This initiative will add \$6.900M of pavement work in the AGFTC Area in the 2022 Construction Season. The funding for this initiative will not count against Regional Planning Targets. There are 5 sites being delivered under multi-site projects and consist of the following:

Warren County:

- Route 9L between Pilot Knob Road and Cleverdale Road in the Town of Queensbury
- Route 9N between Streeter Hill and Essex County in the Town of Hague

Washington County:

- Route 4 between Hudson Falls and Kingsbury Road in the Town of Kingsbury
- Route 4 between Route 22 and Village of Whitehall, Towns of Fort Ann and Whitehall
- Route 22 between Route 40 and Route 4 in the Towns of Granville and Fort Ann
